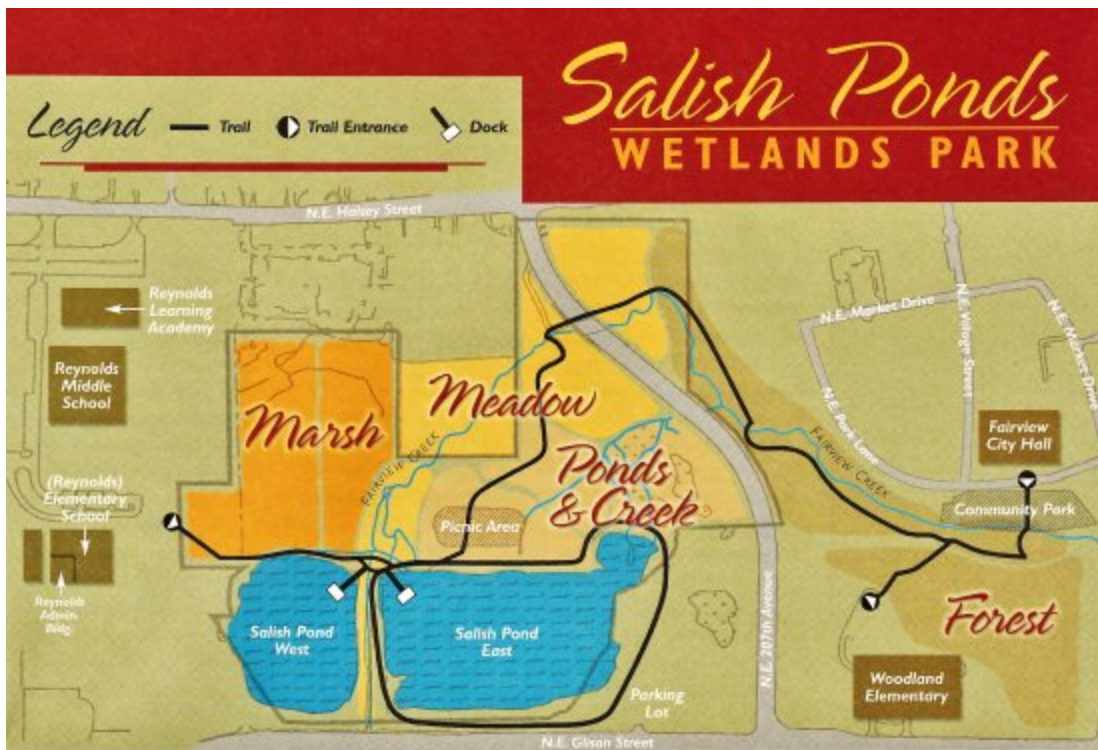


At Salish Ponds, can you find:

<p>A PLACE TO GO FISHING</p>	<p>A SIGN WITH LOTS OF BIRDS ON IT</p>	<p>WOOD THAT A BEAVER CHEWED ON</p>
<p>DUCKS</p>	<p>THE INATAY BRIDGE</p>	<p>SALISH PONDS ELEMENTARY</p>
<p>AN HERB (a little green plant with no wood that grows flowers)</p>	<p>A SHRUB or a BUSH (a plant that has no central trunk but has lots of woody stems and can grow flowers!)</p>	<p>A TREE (a plant that has a central trunk made of wood and can grow REALLY TALL)</p>
<p>A PART OF FAIRVIEW CREEK WHERE OXYGEN IS MIXING INTO THE WATER (look for a place with a little waterfall - can you hear the water moving?)</p>	<p>A POLLINATOR VISITING A FLOWER (a bee, a hummingbird, a butterfly!)</p>	<p>SCAT</p>
