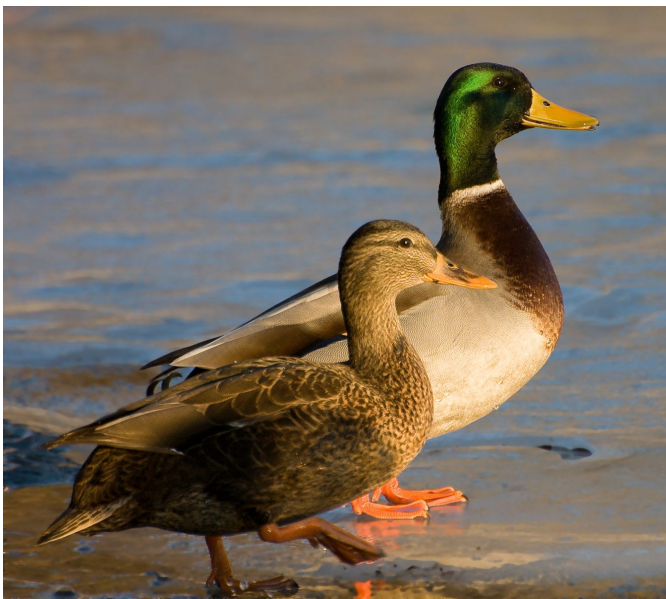

WESTERN PAINTED TURTLE

(Yellow & green stripes on head & legs; top shell (carapace) dark green/brown, bottom shell (plastron) red/orange with black pattern; adults avg. 8-10" in length.)



WESTERN POND TURTLE

(Head & legs vary from dark brown to cream with mottling; top shell (carapace) dark green/black, bottom shell (plastron) cream/yellow with black mottling; adults avg. 8-10" in length.)
